What started as a proof of concept and side project grew into a small-scale game hosting company. However due to local bandwidth limitations are no longer taking on new customers. I am personally responsible for the planning and deployment of an OpenStack cluster based on the Liberty release. Including all hardware provisioning, network configuration and coupling of all required frameworks. Fully redundant 8kw UPS with secondary solar array and standby generator. Fault tolerant pfSense firewalls load balancing multiple WAN connections. Storage backend consists of a Ceph cluster configured into a quorum to meet our SLA in the event of a drive or node failure. Responsible for deployment of isolated tenant environments and web front end. This platform also houses a separate development environment that we use for validating new technologies and continued education in compute related technologies.
